Dear Regional Manager,

Re: Formal Complaint Badja 2029/1 forestry operations.

We contend that the forestry operations approved and commenced on 24th November 2010 in Badja State Forest compartment 2029-1 are in contravention of the legal requirements of NSW.

1. The harvest plan on page 2 states the "Southern Region Draft IFOA requirements" which are non-existent.
2. On page 13 the plan states no records of Spotted-tailed Quolls, but there are sightings of Spotted-tailed Quolls on Balook Road. I personally sighted a quoll in 2001 in the compartment, this was reported to FNSW. It is incorrect to say there are no records. When were FNSW pre-logging flora/fauna surveys conducted in this compartment?
3. On page 37, or amendment page 1, is in error stating the compartment number as "2019-1", this is carried through the rest of the amendment pages.

Further to the above, having personally surveyed this compartment we are aware of the rockiness of the terrain. Given the ongoing intransigence of FNSW and its ability to properly identify rocky outcrops, we have grave concerns that the IFOA requirements will not be adhered to in this compartment, and may have actually been breached by the operations conducted so far.

Therefore we request that any further intention to conduct forestry operations in cpt 2029-1 be forgone, and that you receive this letter as a **formal complaint** regarding the damage that has been incurred in the period 24-27 November 2010. We request that the new roading be rehabilitated and closed.
